



IMPORTANT INFORMATION WHEN UPGRADING FIRMWARE

Please adhere to the following:

- ◆ Do not power down your router or computer while the firmware upgrade is being performed as this may result in damage to your unit.
- ◆ Please perform the upgrade via a wired connection, DO NOT upgrade the firmware wirelessly.
- ◆ Do not have any Anti Virus or Firewall programs running while the upgrade is being performed, these programs may not allow the use of .bin files and may halt the upgrade process.
- ◆ It is recommended to close down any software applications or tasks running on your PC to minimise the possibility of interruption to the upgrade process.
- ◆ It is highly recommended (but not essential) that your PC be issued with a static IP address while performing the upgrade.
- ◆ Performing an upgrade to your unit will erase all settings and configurations prior to the upgrade. Please back up your configuration by "Back up and Restore" on the One Page setup.

How to upgrade your firmware

1. Save attached file to your hard drive.
2. Perform a Hardware reset to your unit via the reset button on the back of the unit. Ensure that any prior configuration has been erased.
3. Log into the One Page Setup (<http://192.168.1.1>)
4. From the menu on the left hand side, click on 'Upgrade Firmware'
5. If the new Window comes up saying 'Upgrade Firmware', click on the 'Browse' button
6. Locate the file you saved on to the system from the Step1 and click on 'Open'
7. From the 'Upgrade Firmware' page, click on 'Upgrade' button and wait until the upgrade is complete.
