- 1. Connect the power adapter to the power socket of your router. Plug the power adapter into the wall socket and switch on.
- 2. Give one minute for the **3GM2WN** to power up.
- 3. Connect the computer to Ethernet port on the **3GM2WN**.
- **4.** Open any web browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox, etc) on your computer, type in http://192.168.20.1 on the address bar, and then press **Enter**.
- 5. Type in the System Password (the default one is *admin* for both Username and Password) then press Login.
- 6. Click Switch to advanced view and navigate to Toolbox > Firmware Upgrade
