

V24W VoIP Setup Guide for MyNetFone Customers

Before configuring the V24W you need some information from MyNetFone like: -

- MyNetFone Username/Phone number
- MyNetFone Password
- SIP Proxy Server/Domain Name from MyNetFone
- Codec
- Expire time

If you have this information then we can start configuring the device.

1. Go to Menu.
2. Then select SIP Settings.
3. Enter the following information: -

Proxy IP	sip.mynetfone.com.au
Proxy Port	5060
Register Proxy IP	sip.mynetfone.com.au
Register Proxy Port	5060
Outbound Proxy IP	sip.mynetfone.com.au
Outbound Proxy Port	5060
Expire Time	240
Display Name	MyNetFone phone number
User Name	MyNetFone phone number

Password	MyNetFone Password
Payload Codec	Given by MyNetFone
Packet Time	Small
DMTF Relay	Disabled
UDP Port	5060
RTP Port	2070
Session Timer	0
SIP Format	Normal

Now return to main screen, where you should see that the V24W has registered the SIP proxy.

Please note that your wireless network needs to be connected, only then will the V24W register the SIP proxy successfully.
